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## Step 1. Application for Getting an Ethical Approval and a License for working with students at schools

- In Hungary the ruling of this area is not strict:
- We need not apply for an Ethical approval and a License
- We only need to inform the **regulation centers (KLIK)** of the involved public schools or the maintainers of denominational/foundational schools about the program
- What we need to collect before any intervention with schoolchildren is their parents' declaration of consent (in case parents do not consent, their child should be excluded from the tests)
- Deadline: two weeks before pretest

# Invitation

## STEP 2 Open call – Invitation for teachers to participate in the program

An invitation letter will be formulated and then

- **distributed** via
  - Official emails from the Center for Teacher Training of PTE to the partner schools of PTE (there is a whole network of schools all over the country)
  - Personal invitation by university colleagues who teach at postgraduate programs for teachers
  - Personal invitation by university colleagues who meet schoolteachers in formal and informal settings
- **published** in different public platforms including
  - Website of the Institute of Education Sciences
  - Website of the ProMeToM Project
  - Facebook (official sites of the University)
- Deadline: 1st November
- The person in charge for the formulation and the first distribution of the invitation letter – Ágnes Bálint
- Other distributors: university colleagues from the Institute of Education Sciences

## Step 3: Pilot test in January-February 2023

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- „Validation and Reliability of measures will be established through pilot-testing in all participating countries, as well as the finalization of coding schemes.”
- Pilot test will be conducted with 10 teachers and 10 students from each country (5 from primary and 5 from secondary schools) accordingly.
- Tasks:
  - select the sample,
  - translation of all measures in Hungarian
  - Inform school regulation center/maintainers of the selected school
  - ask for parents' consent
  - deliver the pilot tests
  - In the light of the results see whether it is necessary to modify the tools or not

## Tasks:

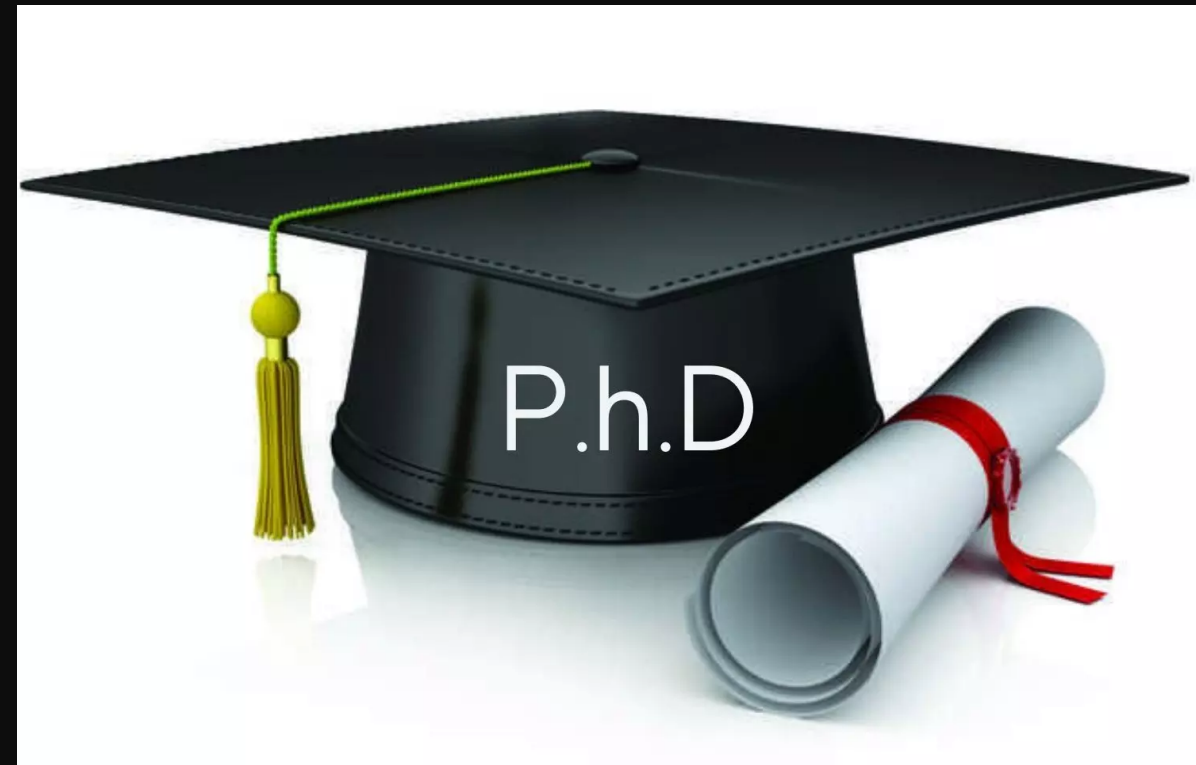
- Creation of staff (coordinator, volunteers)
